Part 4: Daniel Rumbolt - Assistant Director of Eastern Edge

7. What was your main role during the days of the festival?

Well, I think I was in a pretty unique situation when it came to HOLD FAST. I had just began working part-time at Eastern Edge at the beginning of July, and everything was completely new for me. I like to say it was certainly a "trial by fire" sort of situation—I started working right in the middle of the busiest time of the year for EE, but I don't think I would have it any other way. It was a whirlwind of learning new things, meeting new people, and having some incredible experiences during HOLD FAST. And of course, I got to see all of the tremendous behind-the-scenes work that goes into planning the festival—it really was inspiring to see it all come together.

8. Why do you think it's important to have a festival like this in Newfoundland?
